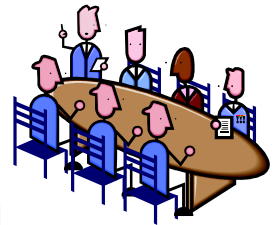
If you are unable to make any of the registration days you are welcome to contact me on 0409 134 133 and I will organise a day and time to sign you up.

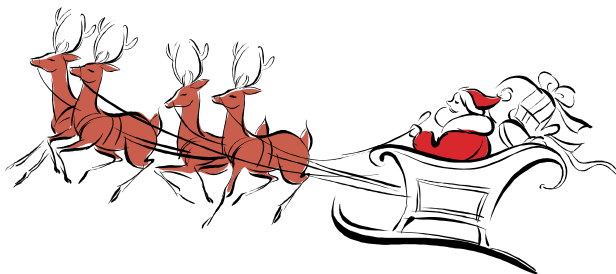

Gibson (Harley-Davidson) was second, and L. Turner (R.S.A.) third. The points competition was terminated by these events, the winner being N. Parker (New Hudson), 71 points; S. Day (A.J.S.) was second with 68; L. Oodfield (R.S.A.) third, 50, and A. McKinnis (Hodge) fourth, 47. On Saturday next, February 6, the annual petrol consumption test will be held.

Recent advice states that a meritorious motorcycle-aided record was established in Tasmania on January 26, when Owen Bruce, with C. Grigg as passenger, drove from Hobart to Launceston—a distance of 121 miles—in 7 hours 26 minutes, which is 18 minutes faster than the previous record established on a 7 h.p. machine. The credit responsible for the new record was a Dunlop-shod standard model 3½ h.p. A.J.S. with sidecar. Several delays were experienced along the route owing to traffic, necessitating a slackening of speed.
